He is Chair of the External Advisory Board of StandICT.eu, H2020 Partner in StandICT2023.eu and Co-Lead on ELITE-S Fellowship Programme for Emerging Technologies Standardization (Elite-Fellowships.eu). Ray was appointed to the Working Group IEEE European Public Policy Committee on ICT in 2019 and is currently the AI WG Lead for IEEE EPPC.

Other roles include Digital Leader with World Economic Forum , NSAI National Expert on Cloud, Big Data and AI, , ISO/IEC AI Standards Editor, Editor for the International Journal of ICT Standards (JICTS), Member of Editorial Board of JICTS, Member of H2020 Think Tank - ThinkNEXUS, PICASSO EU-US Technologies Expert and Member Next Generation Internet NGI Consultation Platform. In February 2019 Ray was appointed Member of United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) Regulatory Cooperation and Standardization Policies. In 2020 Ray was appointed United Nations Gender Responsive Standards Initiative (GRSI) Lead of the Working Group on Network Development and also appointed to OECD Network of Experts in AI (ONE AI).
