

DR. ALİ TAHA KOÇ

Dr. Ali Taha Koç was born in Ankara in 1980.

Having completed his undergraduate education in 2001 at Bilkent University, department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering with full scholarship, he completed his graduate study and doctorate at Texas University, department of Dallas Electrical Engineering, again with scholarship.

Having joined in 2006 to Intel in USA as a research and development (R&D) engineer, Koç developed 61 patents, 23 articles of him were published in scientific journals, and he developed and supervised many international projects in the period during which he was with Intel. In 2013, he was awarded as one of the 10 engineers who produced highest number of patents at Intel.

After having returned to Turkey in 2014, he come into office as Principal Consultant of Prime Ministry, and he was appointed to Department of Information Technologies of the Presidency in the same year. Simultaneously, he supervised the process of establishment of State Information Coordination Center (DBKM) at the Department of Security Policies of the Presidency, and in this context, he provided flow of information from all the ministries and security departments to the Presidency.

With the Presidential decree which was published on the Official Gazette dated September 12, 2018, he was appointed to the Digital Transformation Office.

Being a board member of Türksat Uydu Haberleşme Kablo TV ve İşletme A.Ş. in addition to his offices at the Presidency, Koç is also giving master's degree and doctorate lectures at Bilkent University, department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering.

He is also a licensed pilot, he is married and he speaks English in an advanced level.
