Gary R. Bunt's research focuses on Islam, Muslims and the Internet. His most recent book is '*Hashtag Islam: How Cyber-Islamic Environments Are Transforming Religious Authority*' (University of North Carolina Press, 2018). In this book, he explores the diverse and surprising ways digital technology is shaping how Muslims across vast territories relate to religious authorities in fulfilling spiritual, mystical, and legalistic agendas. Other publications include *iMuslims* (University of North Carolina Press, 2009), *Islam in the Digital Age* (Pluto Press, 2003) and *Virtually Islamic* (University of Wales Press, 2000). He is Professor of Islamic Studies at the University of Wales Trinity Saint David, working on a variety of modules at undergraduate and postgraduate levels, including 'Islam in the West' and 'Muslim Networks'.
