

PROF. MEHMET AKGÜL

He was born in Sarıveliler/Karaman in 1965. He completed his and secondary school education in Karaman (1983); hid undergraduate education at Atatürk and Selçuk Universities, Faculty of Theology (1983-88). In 1989, he became Research Associate at S.Ü. Faculty of Theology, Sociology of Religion Discipline. After completion of his Master's degree on the basis of his study entitled "Sanayileşme ve Din İlişkisi" (Relation of Industrialization and Religion) (1991), he received his Ph.D (1996) upon his dissertation entitled "Türk Modernleşmesi ve Din" (Turkish Modernization and Religion) (Çizgi Yayınları, Konya: 1999). He became Associate Professor in 2005 and Professor in 2010.

During the term following the award of his Ph.D, he pursued research and academic studies both in Turkey and abroad (Egypt, Germany), he published several books entitled "Türkiye'de Din ve Değişim"; "Bir Erol Güngör Çözümlemesi" (Ötüken Neşriyat, İstanbul: 2002) and "Cumhuriyet'in Erken Dönem Din Anlayışı" (Adal Ofset, Konya, 2010). Furthermore, he authored many scientific articles and conducted research such as "Modernization and Religion", "Religion and Change", "Relation of Media and Religion", "Senium and Religion", "Globalism and Religion", "İnternet/Digitalization and Religion". He is in the course of publishing his study entitled "Religious Groups and New Religious Movements in Turkey".

In addition to carrying out teaching and education activities as well as scientific and academic research at N.E. University, Faculty of Theology, he is the Dean of Karamanoğlu Mehmetbey University, Faculty of Islamic Sciences.
